

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the following is a true and attested copy of a resolution adopted by the Council of the City of Norwich at a meeting held on November 7, 2022, and that the same has not been amended or rescinded:

To allocate American Rescue Plan funds for replacement of the boiler at the Norwich Police station.

**WHEREAS**, the Norwich Police station was constructed in 1979; and

**WHEREAS**, the original boiler at the Norwich Police station began leaking in late October 2022 and is in imminent danger of failing; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to expedite the acquisition of the equipment and materials to replace the boiler, the City contracted with EMCOR Services New England Mechanical on November 4, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost to replace the boiler and related equipment and abate any hazardous materials is estimated at \$150,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Norwich finds that this project is consistent with the plan objectives of the American Rescue Plan; can be obligated within the time allotted; will respond to American Rescue Plan Expenditure Category "6.1 Provision of Government Services."

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWICH**, that \$150,000 be appropriated from American Rescue Plan funds to the Norwich Police Departments to replace the boiler and related equipment and abate any hazardous materials.
