WHEREAS, the Lafayette Trail memorializes and maps the final tour of Gilbert du Motior, the Marquis de Lafayette, in the United States (1824-1825); and

WHEREAS, efforts spearheaded by the Consulate of France in Boston have been and are being made to memorialize the tour of the Marquis de Lafayette, the last surviving Major General of the Continental Army, in connection with the Bicentennial of his Farewell Tour; and

WHEREAS, the Marquis de Lafayette visited Norwich on August 22, 1824 during his tour and dined at the Kinney's/Merchant Hotel which was located on Main Street near where the Main Street Parking Garage currently stands; and

WHEREAS, the Norwich Historical Society is in the process of planning a commemoration of this milestone event to take place on August 22, 2024 and has proposed to the city, as part of this event, the unveiling of a sign on the 200th anniversary of his visit to Norwich, the sign to be 2' x 3' in dimensions, made of cast aluminum and mounted on a 7' aluminum pole bearing this information

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Trail program has an arrangement with the Pomeroy Foundation to pay for and fabricate such signs, with agreeing to accept such sign and the installation of the same to remain a responsibility of the City of Norwich; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director has recommended the placement of the sign on the south side of Main Street near the intersection of Main Street and Market Street.

WHEREAS, the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), adopted by Congress and codified as 20 U.S.C.A. section 1400, et seq., initially proposed the commitment of 40% federal funding to support the IDEA, while actual funding has fallen far short of this figure; and

WHEREAS, the federal government continues to fail to meet its initial promise and fails to meet the expectation of those students who would benefit from full performance and those of communities in which the students reside; and

WHEREAS, the IDEA Full Funding Act was introduced before Congress in 2023 and offers an opportunity to rectify the many years of underfunding and an increased possibility to result in a free and appropriate public education (FAPE) for children with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Norwich finds it would be in the best interest of the students and residents of Norwich if the IDEA Full Funding Act were taken up and given serious consideration by the Congress of the United States.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWICH, that City Manager John Salomone be and hereby is authorized and directed to send a communication satisfactory to him to all members of the Connecticut Delegation in Congress, members of the Senate and of the House of Representatives for the State of Connecticut expressing the support of the Council of the City of Norwich for the IDEA Full Funding Act and to provide such additional information or statistics as may be requested by senator or member of the House of Representatives serving now or in terms to commence in January of 2025.
