RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR REFERENDUM

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWICH:

That the ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$3,200,000 FOR PUBLIC SAFETY EQUIPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF \$3,200,000 BONDS OF THE CITY TO MEET SAID APPROPRIATION AND PENDING THE ISSUANCE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE", as adopted by this meeting of the Council, be submitted to a referendum vote of the electors of the City for approval or disapproval in conjunction with the general election on November 7, 2017, between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. and that the warning of said referendum state the question to be voted upon and the ballot label with respect thereto as follows:

Question 1:

"Shall the ordinance entitled 'AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$3,200,000 FOR PUBLIC SAFETY EQUIPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF \$3,200,000 BONDS OF THE CITY TO MEET SAID APPROPRIATION AND PENDING THE ISSUANCE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE', as adopted by the City Council on July 17, 2017, be approved? YES NO"

The ballot label for said question shall read as follows:

"Shall the \$3,200,000 appropriation and bond authorization for the purchase of (i) an engine tanker for the East Great Plain Volunteer Fire Department, (ii) a rescue pumper and a large squad vehicle for the Taftville Volunteer Fire Department, (iii) a pumper for the Yantic Volunteer Fire Department, (iv) a pumper for the Laurel Hill Fire Department, and (v) any additional public safety equipment, including communications equipment, as later determined and approved by resolution of the City Council as may be accomplished within said appropriation, pursuant to the ordinance adopted by the City Council on July 17, 2017, be approved? YES NO"

The voting will be by paper/electronic ballot. Those desiring to vote for the question shall fill in the box in front of the question on the ballot at "**YES**". Those desiring to vote against the question shall fill in the box in front of the question on the ballot at "**NO**". Absentee ballots will be made available in accordance with the law.

The warning of said referendum shall also state that the full text of the aforesaid ordinance and question are on file open to public inspection in the office of the City and Town Clerk, that the vote on the aforesaid bond ordinance is taken pursuant to Chapter VIII, Section 4 of the City Charter and Chapters 90 and 152 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, and that absentee ballots will be made available in accordance with the law.

WHEREAS, the City of Norwich acquired the property located at 19 Ward Street by a Foreclosure by Sale Committee Deed recorded on September 13, 2016 at volume 2979, page 33 of the Norwich Land Records; and

WHEREAS, Allyn and Associates Realtors has received an offer on behalf of the City of Norwich to purchase said property from Eric and Kevin Dingman at a price of \$27,550 as a cash sale without mortgage contingencies; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that selling said property at a price of \$27,550 would be in the best interest of the City of Norwich;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWICH that, City Manager John Salomone be and hereby is authorized and directed on behalf of the City of Norwich to enter into a Real Estate Listing Agreement satisfactory to him with Allyn and Associates Realtors offering to the sell the property at 19 Ward Street at a price of \$27,550;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWICH that, upon receipt of a Purchase and Sales Agreement listing a purchase price of \$27,550 and containing such terms and conditions as are satisfactory to him, City Manager John Salomone, he be and hereby is authorized and directed to enter into said Purchase and Sales Agreement between the buyer Eric and Kevin Dingman and the City of Norwich and upon timely tender of such sum subject to standard adjustments to execute, and deliver a deed of conveyance for the property known as 19 Ward Street, Norwich and to execute, receive and deliver such other documents as are necessary to complete the transfer of title in keeping with the terms of the Purchase and Sales Agreement.
