

### Items allowed for curbside pickup:

 <p>Tires (without rims)</p>	 <p>Furniture &amp; Mattresses</p>	 <p>Carpeting (rolled or folded)</p>
 <p>Scrap Wood (neatly stacked)</p>	 <p>Household Appliances (see exceptions below)</p>	 <p>Metal (max. 50 pounds per piece)</p>

There are no restrictions on amount of acceptable items allowed, providing the overall pile is within the size guideline of 6 ft x 10 ft x 4ft. (about the size of a standard pickup truck bed.)

You must call Willimantic Waste at **860-423-4527** to schedule a pickup. Residents are entitled to two free pickups per calendar year. If you can't wait for a pickup or have already used your two free pickups, you can always bring items to the Norwich Transfer Station located on Rogers Road.

### Items NOT allowed for curbside pickup (but accepted at the Norwich Transfer Station):

 <p>Electronics</p>	 <p>Appliances that contain Freon (i.e., Refrigerators, Air Conditioners, Freezers, Humidifiers/Dehumidifiers)</p>	 <p>Empty Propane Tanks</p>
 <p>Toilets, Sinks, Tubs, and Shower Stalls</p>	 <p>Shingles, Drywall (sheetrock) &amp; other Construction Debris</p>	<p><b>Hazardous waste items are not allowed for pickup or for disposal at Transfer Station</b></p>

The City of Norwich Transfer Station is located on Rogers Road, accessible from Wawecus Street or Wawecus Hill Road. Hours of operation are Monday - Friday from 8AM - 3 PM; Saturday 8 AM - 1 PM.
