Question: What is your name and position with Norwich Public Utilities ("NPU") and the Connecticut Municipal Electric Energy Cooperative ("CMEEC")?

Answer: My name is Diana Boisclair; I am a commissioner for NPU. I have been a commissioner since 2003. My fellow commissioners appointed me Chair in 2015. I am currently an alternate for CMEEC for Norwich Public Utilities.

Question: How and why were you invited to participate in the May 2016 CMEEC Board retreat in Kentucky?
